- 1. No exhibit shall be staged for competition until subscription or entrance fees are paid to the Society. Fees may be paid with entries submitted online through our website, albanyshow.org.au.
- The committee reserves the power to reject or remove any Exhibitor, servant or attendant, or any visitor from the Show without being required to give any explanation or being liable for compensation. The powers conferred on the committee shall be delegated to the Secretary and all monies won by such offenders shall be forfeited.
- 3. **NO DOGS**, excepting registered Assistance Dogs or dogs for exhibition/competition, will be allowed on the grounds.



- 4. The committee reserves the right to postpone, and further postpone any Show from the advertised date, and may make any alterations it deems desirable in the schedule of prizes, or other show arrangements.
- 5. The decision of the Society on all points shall be final and without recourse.
- 6. NO GATE ENTRY FEE AND/OR MEMBERSHIP FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.
- 7. Quantities, weights and numbers will be strictly adhered to.
- 8. All persons competing and exhibiting in the Show do so at their own risk.
- 9. No protest will be considered if person protesting has not an entry in the class concerned.
- 10. The Head Steward of each section reserves the right to reject and remove from the ground any exhibit, which is in their opinion dangerous or objectionable.
- 11. The Albany Agricultural Society Incorporated Committee will not be held liable for loss of or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the grounds.
- 12. Stewards reserve the right to re-enter an entry into a more appropriate section and/or class.
- 13. Please ensure all vehicles are removed immediately after they have been unloaded and parked offsite in public parking zones. All vehicles parked illegally upon the grounds shall be **TOWED AWAY WITHOUT NOTICE.**
- 14. NO ALCOHOL is to be brought onto the grounds.

NOTICES

All exhibitors must pay entrance fee to the grounds on Show Days.

Exhibitors will please check individual sections for times that exhibits in the various sections must be in place. These times will be rigidly adhered to.

Exhibits MUST NOT be dismantled or removed from the ground before 5:00pm on Saturday.

In the event of there being no competition in any particular Class, prizes may be given if the judges certify to particular merit, however, they are specifically requested to with-hold prizes - even where there is competition if the exhibits are of inferior description, or not suitable for the class in which they are competing, they may be awarded a 2nd prize.

Prize money where applicable will be available at the Secretary's office from 9.00am Monday 11 November 2024. If you are GST registered, you must provide a tax invoice to the Albany Agricultural Society to claim prize money including GST. All prize money not collected by **22 November 2024** (or tax invoices not lodged) will revert back to the Society.

RULES OF ENTRY:

Photographs MUST be taken, but not necessarily processed, by the exhibitor. Any modification of the image must be done by the exhibitor or under their personal direction.

- <u>Any one image</u> may be entered in <u>one class only</u> and derivatives of that image may not be submitted as separate images in other classes.
- Entries exhibited at previous Albany Agricultural Shows are not permitted.
- Competition is open to all amateur photographers. Definition of Amateur for this competition is someone who does not get the majority of their income from photography.
- Prizes to be awarded on the Judge's decision. Prizes are not necessarily awarded.
- Photo contest staff and judges are not allowed to enter the competition.
- Entries must not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libelous, defamatory, obscene or pornographic content.
- All entries must be captured in accordance with local laws and regulations including any permits, licences and permissions (including drone laws).
- Failure to comply with the rules of entry and presentation will result in non-acceptance.
- All accepted entries will be submitted for judging but all may not be displayed if insufficient space available.
- The Society will encourage the sale of photography entries which are exhibited during the period of the show. Commission of 10% + GST will be charged by The Albany Agricultural Society for such sales.
- Payments of proceeds to exhibitors of sold exhibits will be via electronic funds transfer only. Payments will occur no later than the end of November 2024. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to ensure their bank details are correct.
- On the entry form please place either a NFS (not for sale) or a dollar amount in the area provided.

COMPETITION CATEGORIES:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MOUNTING OF PRINT ENTRIES:







- **Snapshots –** must be card mounted on hard card or mount/Mat Board.
- Enlargements all prints over 15 x 10cm must be securely mounted with stiff cardboard/Mat board, (Wood, chipboard, ply or similar mounts will not be accepted).
- Prints (including mount board) must be no thicker than 5mm.
- All prints must be mounted singularly.
- Correct part of Exhibitors Ticket must be taped to the **centre** of bottom edge of mount.
- On the **reverse** side must be your **name and address**, **subject title**, **class and section** and to be marked to indicate top when viewed correctly.
- No hangers or velcro to be attached to the mount please.
- No title or name to be written on the front of entry.
- Examples of mounting will be on display in Agricultural Society Office. If in doubt please check.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES:

- **1.** Entries can be completed online through the website (<u>www.albanyshow.org.au</u>). Or in person at the Agricultural Society Office. Entries close 4th November 2024.
- Entries with EXHIBITORS CARD ATTACHED must be benched on Wednesday 6th November 2024 between 4:00pm and 6:00pm in the Exhibition Pavilion at 88 Cockburn Road, Albany 6330. They may be lodged at Show Office prior to 4:00pm on Wednesday 6th November 2024. ENTRIES CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 6:00PM.

The portion of entry card returned to the exhibitor should be retained for presentation on collection of entries.

 Removal (only by stewards) between 5:00pm – 5:30pm on Saturday 9th November 2024. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE. Stewards must sight entrant's portion of exhibitor's card. Entries and prize money or vouchers not collected at this time will be held at the Agricultural Society Office until 22nd November 2024.

DEFINITION OF SUBJECTS

OPEN - any subject treated pictorially. Images for the OPEN category **should not** be of subjects that could have been entered in another category; for instance – the subject should not be a landscape.

LANDSCAPE - picture of natural scenery which may include trees, people, houses or other objects, provided that these elements do not dominate the picture.

SEASCAPE - a picture of natural coastal scenery, a wave study or picture of the open sea, boats and other items of marine interest may be included as incidental items provided that these elements do not dominate the picture.

PLANTS & ANIMALS – must be living. Any kind of animal, domestic or wild, including fish and insects. Any tree, shrub, herb, grass, fern, moss etc. and flowers. Minor retouching to the image is allowed but manipulation that alters the content and truth of the original scene will not be accepted.

PORTRAIT – must be living. Picture of a single person or group of people. A person or persons must be the main element in the photograph and can be candid or posed.

WILDFLOWER – must be of native Australian species photographed insitu whether in garden or bush. May be single or multiple blooms.

RURAL AUSTRALIA – depicting rural Australia through agriculture and life on the land including people, animals, machinery and the rural Australian environment.

No larger than 40cm x 50cm (including mount)

May be black & white or an image containing shades of any one colour. If toning is carried out it must be over the total print. Partial toning or the addition of one extra colour is not acceptable in the Monochrome section. Images with an emphasis on contrast, tone and texture. Focus on composition and subject matter that benefit from the absence of colour, such as portraits, landscapes or abstract scenes.
