RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Society's Annual Show is held under the Society's Rules and Regulations. The committee may add, alter, vary or revoke any Rules and Regulations it may deem advisable.
- 2. No exhibit shall be staged for competition until subscription or entrance fees are paid to the Society. Fees may be paid with entries submitted online through our website, albanyshow.org.au.
- 3. The committee reserves the power to reject or remove any Exhibitor, servant or attendant, or any visitor from the Show without being required to give any explanation or being liable for compensation. The powers conferred on the committee shall be delegated to the Secretary and all monies won by such offenders shall be forfeited.
- 4. **NO DOGS**, excepting registered Assistance Dogs or dogs for exhibition/competition, will be allowed on the grounds.
- 5. The committee reserves the right to postpone, and further postpone any Show from the advertised date, and may make any alterations it deems desirable in the schedule of prizes, or other show arrangements.
- 6. The decision of the Society on all points shall be final and without recourse.
- 7. NO GATE ENTRY FEE AND/OR MEMBERSHIP FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.
- 8. Quantities, weights and numbers will be strictly adhered to.
- 9. All persons competing and exhibiting in the Show do so at their own risk.
- 10. No protest will be considered if person protesting has not an entry in the class concerned.
- 11. The Head Steward of each section reserves the right to reject and remove from the ground any exhibit, which is in their opinion dangerous or objectionable.
- 12. The Albany Agricultural Society Incorporated Committee will not be held liable for loss of or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the grounds.
- 13. Stewards reserve the right to re-enter an entry into a more appropriate section and/or class.
- 14. Please ensure all vehicles are removed immediately after they have been unloaded and parked offsite in public parking zones. All vehicles parked illegally upon the grounds shall be **TOWED AWAY WITHOUT NOTICE.**
- 15. **NO ALCOHOL** is to be brought onto the grounds.

NOTICES

All exhibitors must pay entrance fee to the grounds on Show Days. Exhibitors will please check individual sections for times that exhibits in the various sections must be in place. These times will be rigidly adhered to.

Exhibits MUST NOT be dismantled or removed from the ground before 5:00pm on Saturday.

In the event of there being no competition in any particular Class, prizes may be given if the judges certify to particular merit, however, they are specifically requested to with-hold prizes - even where there is competition if the exhibits are of inferior description, or not suitable for the class in which they are competing, they may be awarded a 2nd prize.

Prize money where applicable will be available at the Society's office from 9.00am Monday 11 November 2024. If you are GST registered, you must provide a tax invoice to the Albany Agricultural Society to claim prize money including GST. All prize money not collected by **22 November 2024** (or tax invoices not lodged) will revert back to the Society.

- Junior Judging competition to commence 2pm Friday 8th November 2024.
- Trophies will be announced 3pm Saturday the 9th November 2024.

SENIOR CLASSES

Exhibit Fee per fleece: \$5.00

Prize Money donated by Westcoast Wool & Livestock First: \$50.00 Second: \$30.00 Third: \$20.00

CONDITIONS:

- No fleece to carry more than 396 days growth.
- All lamb's wool to have a lamb's wool tip in Classes 18 to 24.
- All wool to be current seasons.
- All fleeces must have been produced on exhibitor's property.
- All fleeces must be skirted.
- Fleeces must not be shedded.
- Judge may be empowered to transfer entry into its correct class should the fleece be wrongly entered.

- 1. Super Fine 18.5 micron and under Ram
- 2. Super Fine 18.5 micron and under Ewe or Wether
- 3. Merino Ram, one fleece, fine 18.5 to 20.5 micron
- 4. Merino Ram, one fleece, medium 20.5 to 22.5 micron
- 5. Merino Ram, one fleece, strong 22.5 to 26.0 micron
- 6. Merino Fleece, Ewe or Wether fine 18.5 to 20.5 micron
- 7. Merino Fleece, Ewe or Wether medium 20.5 to 22.5 micron
- 8. Merino Fleece, Ewe or Wether, strong 22.5 to 26.0 micron
- 9. Merino Ewe or Wether, two fleeces, fine 18.5 to 20.5 micron
- 10. Merino Ewe or Wether, two fleeces, medium 20.5 to 22.5 micron
- 11. Merino Ewe or Wether, two fleeces, strong 22.5 to 26.0 micron
- 12. Crossbred, fine, one fleece, 21.0 to 25.0 micron
- 13. Crossbred, one fleece, 25.0 micron or broader
- 14. Merino Lamb's Wool, picked, 18.5 micron or finer minimum weight 1.5kg
- 15. Merino Lamb's Wool, picked, 18.5 to 20.5 micron minimum weight 1.5kg
- 16. Merino Lamb's Wool, picked, 20.5 to 22.5 micron minimum weight 1.5kg
- 17. Crossbred Lamb's Wool, picked, 18.0 to 22.0 micron minimum weight 1.5kg
- 18. Crossbred Lamb's Wool, picked, 22.0 micron and broader minimum weight 1.5kg
