Albany Agricultural Society – Horse Section Rules

- Entry to Grounds: from Cockburn Road into Symers Street – one-way only. Exit from the grounds via Campbell Road.
- Parking: please park as directed by the Gate Marshall. Cars without floats are to be parked in designated parking areas. NOT on the oval.
- ALBANY AG SOCIETY EVENT MEMBERSHIP & GATE ENTRY: applies to all competitors and one strapper who are not financial 2024 members of the Albany Agricultural Society.
 - Event Membership & Gate Entry, \$15/per adult or teenager over 12 years, is payable with your entry. Children 12 & under-Free.
 - All remaining occupants of your vehicle over 12 years need to pay \$15 each per day.

Proof of Payment - i.e., the Horse Entry Receipt (forwarded to you by email after your entry is paid via Nominate) or current Albany Agricultural Society membership must be shown to the Gate Marshall when entering the grounds on Friday and Saturday mornings.

Albany Agricultural Society Inc. (AAS) Membership can be purchased at the AAS Office prior to the Show or online at <https://www.albanysshow.org.au/membership>

- Society's liability: The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such incident.
- Protests: must be lodged within half an hour after the event with a deposit of \$50 to a Councillor for the horse section or the Secretary, which shall be forfeited to the society if the protest on due consideration be deemed unfounded or frivolous.
- Dangerous or diseased exhibits: should the Council have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is dangerous or diseased, it may be removed from or refused admission to the grounds.

Albany Agricultural Society – Horse Section Rules, continued

- Program: The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this program in any way it sees fit without giving prior warning.

Classes may be combined or split at the committee/judge's discretion.

All rings will be running concurrently. Competitors are advised to bear this in mind when submitting entries. CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP FOR A COMPETITOR COMPETING IN ANOTHER RING

- Refunds: non-participation in an event will NOT warrant a refund of entry monies. Entry monies will only be refunded less 20% administration fee if the request is accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian or a Doctor's Certificate dated within 14 days prior to the show.
- Judges: The Judge's decision in all classes is final. Judges are NOT to be approached under any circumstances by any competitor or spectator.
- Entries: all exhibits MUST BE ENTERED under the registered name horse/pony and in the name of the rider.

Height Certificates: all competitors are required to have their height certificates available to view, if requested, on the day.

- Yards and Camping: available at Albany Equestrian Centre (www.albanyequestrian.net).

- Please choose; "Friends of the AEC" for club membership option.
- Cost is \$5.00 per horse per night.
- Enquiries; please contact Karen Mayfield 0408 099 757.
- Hay & Housekeeping: hay is permitted. Excess hay and all manure must be picked up and placed in bin provided.
- Please fill any holes if your horse has damaged the ground.
- Off The Track Classes: all competitors entering the Off The Track classes must successfully apply for their horses OTTWA passport and provide upon entry:
 - Your horses racing name.
 - Horse I.D. number.

No entries will be eligible for Off the Track classes without these requirements being met prior to close of entries.

Entrance and float parking for Horses in Action competitors.

Show Horse Ring Guidelines:

- Horses or Ponies may only compete as either Encourage or Official and may enter as a Show Horse or Hunter, not both.
- Encourage classes are for Horses/Ponies/Riders that have not won more than 3 (official ring or official event) FIRST placing's in, open classes, i.e., height, weight, and ladies/gents/child's classes.
- Even though a Horse or Pony may have competed in official classes, the mount may, in the event of having insufficient wins, return to Encourage ring status.
- Pony exhibits in hack classes can be ridden by rider of any age.
- First ridden is under 12 years and Lead Rein, 4 - 8 years.
- Leaders are to be 18 years or over.
- Age of rider is at the first day of the show.
- Riders can choose to do either Lead Rein or First Ridden, not both.
- First ridden riders may also enter the open classes.
- Encourage classes are to be ridden in a Snaffle.
- Pony Club uniform is acceptable, otherwise shirt, tie and Jacket are required.
- Approved safety helmets and riding boots to be worn whilst mounted.

In-Hand Classes Guidelines:

- \$5 per class entry fee (maximum 3 classes) covers entry into all eligible classes in the section.
- Open to both Encourage & Official horses and ponies.
- Each exhibit to be entered under their registered name and Handler's name must appear on the entry.
- Neat and tidy presentation is a must. Plaiting is not essential.
- Exhibits must be shown in a bridle and the Handler must wear closed toe footwear.
- No stallions or colts permitted.

Off The Track Classes Guidelines:

- Led Exhibits must be shown in a bridle and the Handler must wear closed toe footwear.

- Show Entry Admission:
 - \$15 per adult. (Over 12 years). Includes one strapper.
 - Or 2024 Albany Agricultural Society membership/car pass sticker.
 - All remaining occupants of your vehicle over 12 years, \$15 each.
 - Proof of payment: the Horse Entry Receipt (forwarded to you by email after entry is paid via Nominate) or current Albany Agricultural Society membership must be shown to the Gate Marshall when entering the grounds on Friday and Saturday mornings.
- Rider’s must be entered before the commencement of competition.
